**Message: Lord make me over again!**

**Scripture text: Jeremiah 18:1-6**

**Thesis: *Our Potter specializes in taking marred clay and making it over again!***

1. **Review: (Grow through the Word)**

Who does the Potter represent in the text? vs.6

Who does the clay represent in the text? vs.6

What does the wheel represent in the text? vs.3

How do we know that the Potter had a purpose for the clay? vs. 3, 4

2. **Reflect: (Prayerfully ponder)**

How is it encouraging to know that although we are marred, the Potter wants to make us over again?

In view of all the experiences that you have had on the Potter's wheel, have you come to a place where you have fully surrendered your will to His will?

3. **Rehearse: (Serve)**

Let God **BUILD** your life over again in this brand new year by:

**Admitting** the areas in your life where you are marred

**Believing** that the Potter wants to make you over again

**Confessing** your brokenness and asking God to make you over again

Prayer: Dear Lord, thank you for the blessing of a brand new year. I believe that as my Potter, you have a purpose for my life. I confess that I am marred and have areas of brokenness. I'm grateful that although I'm marred, I'm still in your hands. I repent of my sins and surrender my will to your will. Please make me over again!
